Before & After School

Larks and Owls are the PNEU's before- and after-school clubs. They provide a flexible, useful way for parents and carers to manage their busy schedules at either end of the working day.

Both clubs provide warm, friendly home-from-home environments: girls often ask to attend the clubs, rather than arriving or leaving on time at the beginning and end of their formal school day.

The clubs operate every day during the school term and girls can attend as little or often as needed. Bookings are made through the school office on an ad-hoc, daily, weekly or termly basis.

Larks

Larks pre-school care and breakfast club is open to all girls from 7.45am. It provides a warm, safe and welcoming start to the day, with breakfast available until 8.00am if required. Girls can attend without taking advantage of the breakfast option. Girls attending Larks can enjoy quiet time, talk with their friends or take part in supervised play until the start of the school day, when they are accompanied (younger girls only) to their classrooms.

Owls

Owls after-school club provides a warm, comfortable, home-from-home atmosphere for all girls at the end of their school day and is available from 3pm until 6pm.

For older girls, Owls offers a quiet area where they can complete homework or simply enjoy a peaceful environment. For younger girls, Owls' many activities include art, painting, seasonal craft, reading, dressing-up and a puppet theatre. During the summer months, girls can enjoy supervised play in the garden and use the adventure playground and outdoor activities. Girls are free to watch television or take advantage of the extensive DVD and video collection, but seldom choose to do so. A light teatime meal is offered to all girls who attend Owls.

Sisters' Club:

Girls whose school day finishes when their elder sisters are still attending lessons are eligible for Sisters' Club: this provides complimentary use of Owls for younger girls until their elder sisters' school day has finished.
